The GRE (Graduate Record Examination) general test and subject test are taken by individuals applying to graduate programs in natural sciences, engineering, social sciences, business, humanities and arts, education, and other fields.

Quantitative Reasoning Sections (2)	Quantitative Comparison, Problem Solving, and Data Interpretation	20 questions each	35 min. each
Verbal Reasoning Sections (2)	Text Completion, Sentence Equivalence, and Reading Comprehension	20 questions each	30 min. each

Score Range and Averages

Verbal and Quantitative: scored between 130-170

Average Score: around 150-152

Analytical Writing: scored between 0 and 6

Average Score: around 3.5
